Walawaani, my name is Allirra Moore and I am a proud Yuin woman from Jervis Bay. I acknowledge the beautiful Darkinjung country which I create on and call home. Throughout these drawings I felt quite inspired to hear from other communities. I wanted to include some symbols to represent the presentations from each community. The banner at the beginning of the page for session 1 includes a mountain range to pay tribute to the IJC logo and the artist Garry Jones. Above the writing are stars which represent the ancestors and old people who have come before us.

Honouring the ancestors of not only myself, but also other mob is important and how I pay my respects to culture. Sessions 1, 2 and 3 contain symbols representing journey, footprints, campfires, yarning circles, bush tucker and crosshatching. I also pay my respects to the speakers and the lands they come from/call home.
